I expressed appreciation to Mr. Hansen for the helpful arrangements that had been made for our establishments in Greenland. He thanked me. At the same time, however, he showed displeasure over the fact that both our Ambassador in Copenhagen and Mr. Jones at the State Department had, according to him, criticized Denmark for its inadequate defense effort. He said that he thought that one such criticism would have been enough and that the second one coming from Mr. Jones was redundant.
